Programme Manager: Forest Management

Purpose of the job:

This senior research position, based in Pietermaritzburg, is responsible for leading and managing the ICFR's Forest Management Research Programme, focussed on informing and supporting a range of forest management issues faced by the South African Forest Sector. This includes, but is not limited to, forest operations, forest productivity, forest economics, stand growth and yield projection and forest yield regulation.

Key responsibilities:

- Play a research leadership role, at project, programme and Institute levels, in developing strategic research focus to meet the current and future needs of the forest industry
- Develop and manage projects, applying high quality scientific standards and project management principles
- Be focused on customer care, particularly around proactively identifying and responding to customer needs, and the delivery of research outcomes
- Strive for an ethos of teamwork and an integrated, multi-disciplinary approach at programme & Institute levels
- Ensure close collaboration with researchers internally, other research organisations and the wider forestry industry
- Manage staff and other resources assigned to the programme according to ICFR's policies and procedures, including mentoring and developing staff, and ensuring the safety of staff and other resources by full compliance to the ICFR's Environmental Health and Safety policies and procedures

Minimum requirements:

- A formal forestry qualification at an undergraduate level as well as a post-graduate qualification in forest management, or one of the key aspects of forest management, preferably at the PhD level

- A good understanding of the South African Forest Sector and the forest management issues faced by this sector as well as in-depth knowledge of tree growth in intensively managed stands
- A proven track record of leading multidisciplinary research teams, ensuring delivery of research outcomes to a range of stakeholders, including publishing in peer-reviewed journals

- Ability to design and manage a research project portfolio, lead a team to implement these projects and deliver on research outcomes
- Ability to review research areas and develop strategies for future research, conceptualise and implement new projects, and synthesise research knowledge into integrated frameworks and research tools/products
- Ability to mentor and motivate programme staff
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, particularly scientific writing and presentation skills
