Urban tree diversity in all its aspects, from selection and establishment to biocultural diversity, is the theme of an international conference to be held in Alnarp, Sweden during 16-18 June 2014. This research conference, hosted at the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences in Alnarp, Sweden, and organised by some of the leading international organisations within arboriculture and urban forestry (including ISA and IUFRO's urban forestry group), will discuss various aspects of urban tree diversity.


