Transportation from airport to Seoul National Univeristy

The 'Limousine bus' is a convenient and inexpensive way to get to SNU Gwanak Campus from Incheon International Airport. The Limousine bus number 6017 comes directly from Incheon Airport to SNU Hoam Faculty (guest) House. It takes about 70 minutes to the destination. The Limousine bus service is available every day from 5:40 a.m. to 22:45 p.m. at Incheon International Airport with no charge for the baggage. The bus departs from 6B/13A of the ground level upon arriving at the Incheon Airport to SNU guesthouse. The bus charges 15,000 Won one-way.
