# 4<sup>TH</sup> INTERNATIONAL RUSTS OF FOREST TREES WORKING PARTY CONFERENCE

May 3 to 6, 2010

Aula Bosio dell'Istituto di Scienze Militari Aeronautiche, Viale dell'Aeronautica, Florence, Italy Dear Colleagues,

the Organizing Committee is pleased to invite you to the 4<sup>th</sup> IUFRO International Rusts of Forest Trees Working Party Conference (IRFTWPC) that will be held in Florence, Italy on 3-6 May 2010, at the "Aula Bosio" of the Istituto di Scienze Militari Aeronautiche. This elegant Institute, belonging to the Italian Air Force, is located in the town centre, in the Cascine Park, 150 meters away from the Faculty of Agriculture and Forestry of the University of Florence.

The IUFRO working group 7.02.05 comes back to Italy about three decades after the "Rust of Hard Pines" Conference was first held in Florence in September 1979. Since then, this working group has met around the world, in Athens, Georgia (1984), Banff, Canada (1989), Tsukuba, Japan (1994), Saariselkä, Finland (1998), Yangling, China (2004) and finally in Lake Tahoe, California, (2006). So, it is only fitting, after 30 years, that this working group meet again in Florence.

Past research on rusts of forest trees has provided key contributions in advancing fundamental taxonomy, genetics of host-parasite interaction, breeding strategies, stand management and the phytopathological discipline at large. Novel, high-throughput research tools now enable genome exploration to address crucial questions of the life-history strategy of this fascinating group of biotrophic pathogens. This conference provides the opportunity to communicate our most recent achievements and exchange new ideas. The conference is expected to cover all aspects of up to date research on rusts of forest trees: from taxonomy and phylogeny, to *in vitro* culturing, population genetics, genomics, host-parasite interaction, mycoparasitism and other control strategies, new disease reports. A special session will be dedicated to the *Melampsora* genome project, which is now completed and has become the model tree rust.

The workshop scientific program will be organized in oral and poster presentations. We invite all interested participants to submit abstracts for scientific presentations. Although we will try to accommodate as many presentations as possible, the Scientific Committee, will reserve the right to change your application from an oral presentation to a poster presentation where necessary if time constraints become a problem.

We hope the program will encourage scientific, social and cultural interaction in a relaxed and congenial atmosphere. You are encouraged to take some days off after the workshop to discover the treasurers of art and history in Florence. A field excursion is planned to visit forest stands attacked by pine rusts on the 3rd day, in hilly areas typical of the Tuscan landscape.

To present a paper or a poster, you must submit your completed abstract by **15** January 2010 as an attachment to <u>cecilia.comparini@unifi.it</u>. Please indicate in your message whether your abstract is for an Oral Presentation or a Poster Presentation.

All abstracts must be in Microsoft Word format, Font type and size: Times New Roman 12, Line spacing: single, scientific names in italics. They must indicate Title, Author(s), Address(es) of authors, E-mail of corresponding author. Please underline the name of the presenting author. An example of formatting requirements is included below.

Spelling and grammar should conform to standard British-English usage. Authors are requested to have the abstracts properly revised if necessary. Abstracts will be published in hard copy in the Book of Abstracts.

The format of the posters should not exceed A0 = 84 cm width x 118 cm height. The secretariat will supply dual scotch tape to attach the posters to the poster boards.
