The IUFRO All Division 7 (Forest Health, Pathology and Entomology)



We have just opened **registration** and **abstract submission** of our upcoming All-Division 7 (Forest Health) conference. The conference will cover all forest and tree entomology and pathology topics. The response to our call for session proposals has been excellent; we received more than 20 proposals for thematic sessions.

Because not all who wish to participate will be able to do so in person, we have decided to change the format to a **hybrid-conference** (attendance in person or online via Zoom). However, we hope that we will have a large number of participants coming to Lisbon to enable more personal interactions with our friends and colleagues and to allow participation with the field trips and other side events. With most countries starting to relax their COVID measures and restrictions and with summer coming up, we are optimistic that in-person participation will be possible. In addition, we will implement a number of COVID safety precautions to enable a safe conference.

The conference will take place at the PT Meeting Center, Parque das Nações, outside Lisbon.

General schedule:

The conference will run from 6 to 9 Sept. 2022 (Tuesday to Friday), with a one-day field visit in the middle of the meeting.

Depending on demand, we will offer a **post-congress tour** from Friday afternoon 9 Sept. to Sunday evening 11 Sept. returning to Lisbon (or with an alternative optional connection to the venue of the next 'International Workshop on the Genetics of Tree-Parasite Interactions in Forestry' which will take place the following week (from 12-17 Sept. 2022) in Pontevedra, Galicia, Spain about 500 km north of Lisbon).
