Activities of RG 7.01 'Impacts of air pollution and climate change' and its move to Division 8

Research Group 7.01 organised a meeting on 'Harmonized Growth, Cleaner Environment and Sustainable Forests' at the Guangxi Forestry Research Institute, Nanning, China, in May 2019. In addition, RG 7.01 coorganised a session at the General Assembly of the European Geosciences Union (EGU) 2019 in April 2019 on 'Biomass in future energy and resource systems: impact on land use, climate and environmental services' and participated in the International Conference on "Adaptive Management for Forested Landscapes in transformation" organized by IUFRO RG 8.00 in Posadas, Argentina, in October 2018.
